END OF KEY STAGE TWO (YEAR 6)

Children in Year 6 took part in the assessment arrangements set out by the government. Pupils' knowledge and understanding of core aspects within a much broader curriculum were assessed through six assessments under test conditions.

The results of the SATs (tests) are reported using a scaled score, where a score of 100 represents the expected standard, and a scaled score of 110 - 120 means that a child is working at a higher level of attainment. The highest possible score is 120 and the lowest is 80.

Children were awarded one of the following Teacher Assessment judgements in writing: **Expected Standard**: Working at the expected standard for a child at the end of Year 6. **Greater Depth**: Working at greater depth within the expected standard, with a strong understanding of the curriculum.
