**Collective Worship - Our thinking!** This half-term, we are focusing on the value of 'FORGIVENESS'. We looked at another acrostic poem for the word forgiveness. The children were encouraged to think about their thoughts and whether they showed each aspect well. Children were encouraged to make connections to their lives – real examples that they can think about the value of 'forgiveness'.

We read the story of Zacchaeus. This story can be found in the book of Luke, Chapter 19 verses 1-19.

The children listened to the story ready to find the example of how Zacchaeus had changed his behaviour. We spoke a lot about the meaning of sorry and that the most important part of saying sorry is offering a promise to change behaviours so undesired behaviour does not continue.


