thinking to real experiences in school. The children spoke about the two meanings of sorry, focusing their attention on the need to change their behaviour to ensure similar incidents do not happen.

This week, we focused on 'not holding a grudge.' Two of our Year 6 children read a drama, and we linked it to the Book of Psalms, Chapter 32, verse 1: "Happy are those whose sins are forgiven, whose wrongs are pardoned."

We explored the unhealthiness of storing anger and how this can cause friendship challenges. The children were given a challenge around forgiveness and restoring friednships.

Looking at the prayer below, talk together about...


How do you feel when people hurt you? Do you find it easy to forgive? Are you good at restoring friendships?

New Vicar for St. Francis Church


