



Polite Reminder - Parent / Carer Communications & Code of Conduct

I am aware that a number of Year Groups have set up parent/carers WhatsApp Groups. While I have no doubt that these are a great source of information sharing and checking, I have been made aware of messages that have highlighted some concerns.

I would politely ask that if there are any issues you feel need to be discussed or resolved, you come into school and speak directly with the relevant staff member. This is undoubtedly the best way to reach a solution.

Sadly, I have been shown some chat messages that are not true, which has resulted in a number of unfair comments about the school. Clearly, I cannot 'police' these groups, but I would like to reiterate the need to speak to the relevant staff member to seek clarification and agree on any way forward.

Additionally, there has been a growing number of issues surrounding parent/carers support of school when dealing with certain behaviours. Please be assured that our intention is always good and to do the right thing by all of our children, therefore if you wish to discuss anything that directly involves your child, please come and speak with us with an open mind to understand the specific aspects rather than making assumptions or jumping to conclusions which have led to angry challenges towards staff.

I know this is not all parents/carers, and I would like to extend my thanks to those who have brought these issues to my attention and who support the school when discussing inappropriate behaviours and any resulting consequences.

Easter Holidays – Keep Learning!

Amongst the business of the upcoming holiday, please keep up with any work set for the Easter holiday by class teachers. Read to and with your child. Visit the library to select new books.
