This has been our fundraising week in Year 6 for our class charity: Christian Aid. We have looked at some success stories from the work Christian Aid have done in parts of the world and it has given us a really positive feeling about what we have been able to achieve whilst in school. We have found parts of our challenges tough, but this is completely outweighed by the rewarding feeling we have experienced and we have felt that it has been an honour to be able to do this. The donation page is live for another 30 days.

This year, Christian Aid are working in parts of the world hit hard by climate change. Their aim is to help communities harvest water more easily and to educate people in crops that can grow in adverse weather conditions. £30 will supply a village dam with six taps, £50 will provide enough cement to build a secure dam and £100 will educate 225 farmers in

growing drought-resistant crops - we have raised £728 so far! The money raised will change the lives of hundreds, if not thousands, of people all over the world. I am immensely proud of the children, their families and friends for what we have achieved. Well done and thank you!
