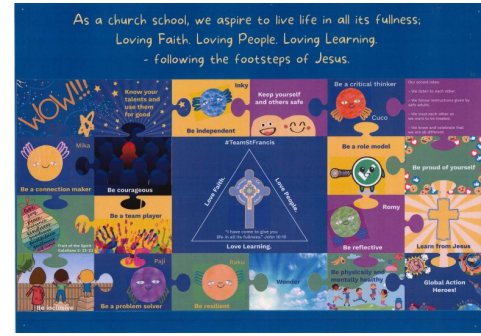

Which stitch is stronger?



Vocabulary	
Whip stitch	A sew with long, spaces stitches.
Running Stitch	A simple needle-work stitch using a line of small even stitches which run back and forth through the cloth without overlapping
Audience	The people reached by television, radio, newspapers or magazines.
Sketches	A quick or rough design, outline, or draft for a written work.
Prototypes	An original model on which later stages or forms are based or developed
Pattern pieces	Shaped pieces used as a template in sewing
Improve	To make better
