School Uniform

The school's uniform is a unisex uniform and any items can be worn by either gender Please note 'G/W' next to an item of clothing means this is available at Grays and Whitakers uniform shop. Other items, if available and unbranded, can be bought from any shop.

Early Reading - EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 Reading Lessons and Phonics Teaching and Learning

This is an advance notice that we will be changing some of the systems that we operate by to teach children early reading, including phonics from September 2021. We will still be using Letters and Sounds, however, we will be moving across to the revised version. The revised version allows for better progression of learning and the purchasing of books that match directly to the revised progression. The revised version is also based on solid learning science that will be forming the basis of our new teaching and learning policy from September.

The revised Letters and Sounds will require much paperwork to be updated. As soon as this is ready, we will send this out to you. The revised Letters and Sounds will also change how we operate home reading. More information will be sent out as soon as we can. It is very exciting though and will continue to strengthen our practice here at St. Francis.

Reading Records

From September 2021, we will be moving away from paper reading records and using Purple Mash's reading record. The focus of this will be for children to record their reading not a communication tool between home and school. Parents/Carers are asked to use their child's year group email address, speak with the teacher at the end of the day or call the school to have a communicate with school.
