

Uniform Reminders

Our new uniform expectations for 2025-2026 were shared in the previous newsletter.

In the meantime however, it is important that for the remainder of this academic year, children continue to come to school in the correct uniform; and uniform reminders and slips will be given out to those children not following our expectations next half term.

As a reminder:

- Trainers and school shoes must be plain black
- Joggers, shorts and hoodies are not to be branded
- If worn, cycle shorts must be knee-length or just above the knee also not branded
- Hair braids and 'extreme' styles are not allowed
- Earrings and other forms of jewellery are not to be worn

Thank you for helping us to maintain good standards of uniform and appearance right up to the end of the year.

Sports Day and Colour Run
