Reporting School Absence - CHANGE - Action Required

Login to your school spider app (please note recently, with a new system, you have already been sent an email about requesting a new password) and then click on 'school home'. This will load a menu to select from. Select 'Report Absence'. Once you have clicked this, you will be able to click 'Report Absences' with the pencil symbol. Previous reported absences will also be shown here.



A form will load. Please complete all sections. Select your child from the 'pupils' drop down and then select the relevant category, select the date and provide a reason for absence.
