Precise knowledge to be learned (include locality links here): Jewish festival of Sukkot and related vocabulary: Sukkah, lulav, Etrog, Jewish, Israel, Egypt

Suitable Visits/Visitors/ Experiences: Build a life-size Sukkot

National/Global Links:

Christianity around the world

Christian Value/SMSC link:

Love, Joy, Goodness, Faithfulness, Self-Control. Tolerance of other faiths (FBV) (shepherds) and rich people: truly an important person for mankind

Suitable texts: Lion Storyteller Bible by Bob Hartman

Suitable resources: The Miracle Maker film clip; look at paintings by Raphael and Rubens

National/Global Links: Jewish weddings; Christian weddings around the world

Christian Value/SMSC link: Peace, Patience, Goodness, Faithfulness. Prior Learning: Children were introduced to the Easter story in EYFS as a celebration of Jesus' death and resurrection

Suitable visits/Visitors/
Experiences: Go for a Spring
Walk, plant seeds to watch
them grow, design an Easter
garden; Walk to church to
look at depictions of the
Easter story – stained glass
window art, candles, crosses
etc.

Suitable texts: Water bugs and Dragonflies by Doris Stickney; The Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle

Suitable resources: Paintings such as - Emmaus by Arcabas (Jean Marie Pirot) Resurrection by Neil McBride Resurrection by Jyoti Sahi (Indian) Jesus passed through death by Stephen B Whatley; watch the opening sequence from Disney's film, The Lion King with the song, The Circle of Life.

National/Global Links: How do Christians, and people of other faiths and no faith around the world celebrate new life and new beginnings?

Christian Value/SMSC link: Love, Joy, Faithfulness. Consider the miracle of new life – a baby being born, a new plant growing, a butterfly emerging from its cocoon etc. Jordan.

Suitable resources: look at photos of baptisms around the world, ask children to bring in pictures of their own baptism if they have any; use the picture file on the CD to look at pictures of fonts and children being baptised in other countries; watch clips of infants from faiths other than Christianity being welcomed into the world according to their family's beliefs

National/Global Links: look at how Christians around the world are baptised

Christian Value/SMSC link: Love, Joy, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness FBV – Tolerance of other faiths, individual liberty to follow on faith or a picture of a person sleeping, the number 12, some stems of wheat, faces with mean expressions, a face with a sad expression and twenty silver coins (see Blackburn Diocese plan)

National/Global Links:

Christian Value/SMSC link: Love, Patience, Kindness, Faithfulness, Self-Control
