SCHOOL RESULTS 2019

END OF KEY STAGE TWO (YEAR 6)

Children in Year 6 took part in the assessment arrangements in 2019. Pupils' knowledge and understanding of the new curriculum was assessed. This curriculum provides greater challenge with higher expectations set for the end of KS2.

The results of the SATs (tests) are reported using a scaled score, where a score of 100 represents the expected standard, and a scaled score of 110 - 120 means that a child is working at a higher level of attainment. The highest possible score is 120 and the lowest is 80.

Children were awarded one of the following Teacher Assessment judgements in writing: **Expected Standard**: Working at the expected standard for a child at the end of Year 6. **Greater Depth**: Working at greater depth within the expected standard, with a strong understanding of the curriculum.
