### Think then Click

**These rules help us to stay safe online whilst using the Internet.**

- ✓ We tell a grown up if something we see makes us feel worried or we are unsure about something.
- ✓ We only use the internet when an adult is with us who has given us permission.
- ✓ We only click on the buttons or links when we know what they do.
- ✓ We only search the Internet with an adult in a safe way.
- ✓ We always ask for help if we get lost on the Internet.
- ✓ We only send and open safe emails and messages together with an adult.
- ✓ We only write polite and friendly emails and messages to people that we know.
- ✓ We keep our personal information, our name, address, our school, our pictures 'Top Secret' and do not share on the internet.
