Worship Theme

We have continued our value of kindness this week and we looked at the bible story from Luke chapter 15 verses 4-6. This story was told by Jesus to illustrate God's love for us. It is the story of the lost sheep. This story remind us that God notices needs and He wants us to notice the needs of those around us. We thought about lots of questions, for example, 'will you use your eyes to notice people in need around you today?' and 'will you show kindness to those people who need help?' We also listen to a short drama that involved Bella and Barney, which saw Bella and her mum stopping to show kindness to a young boy who was lost even though it made her late.



Talk to your child(ren) about:

- What does 'noticing a need' mean?
- How does it make you feel when you see someone who is upset or lost or fed up?
- How have you shown kindness this week?
- Can we shown kindness to our Global Neighbours? How could we do this?

As explained in previous newsletters, we are changing the system we use to communicate with parents. We are moving to a company called 'School Spider'. Thank you to all parents/carers who have downloaded the app, registered, and signed into their account.

School Spider is only integrating with our system for 'priority 1' contacts who live at the same address. If two parents, living at the same address as the child, wish to have access to the app, please share username and password details for this purpose. Parents/Carers who live at separate addresses should be able to set up separate accounts.

If you have not downloaded the app, please do so and then use the following link to set up your account. https://parents.schoolspider.co.uk/password/forgot

You need to input the email address you use for your school communication and select 'St Francis C of E Primary School' from the school list.

This will send you an email with a link to create your parent account. **This expires after 60 minutes**.

Please note, passwords need to include the following -

Please be aware that ParentMail will cease at the end of this month and all communication will take place through School Spider. It is vital that you download the app and register your account. Please note, we are able to see that 20 people have downloaded the app and link it to our school but have not actually signed in and therefore, you will not receive any form of communication.

Please contact the office as a matter of urgency if you are unable to register for an account, as this will be our only way of communicating with you moving forward.

Our website will change over the next month and the calendar and newsletters will be available through School Spider app also. We really do hope that this will improve parent/carer communication.

Reminder: Reading Books – When will they be changed?

Please ensure your child's reading book is brought to school on a Friday for it to be changed and sent back out on the following Monday.

Wellies and outdoor clothing


