# **Remote and Blended Learning**

If your child is off school ill, then no access to learning will be available, however, if your child is absent due to self-isolation and they are well then access to learning will be facilitated. Whilst the school remains open, children will be invited to join lessons virtually. The office staff will run through a series of questions relating to the absence so appropriate provisions can be made.


# Year 3 - A note from Mrs Carter
