Collective Worship - This week...

We have lit the second candle on our advent wreath.

Advent is an important part of the Christian calendar.

It means 'coming' and it's the period before Christmas which celebrates the birth of Jesus.

It is all about preparing for Christmas Day.

The second candle, also purple, represents faith. It is called the "Bethlehem Candle" as a reminder of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem. Bishop Philip spoke to us about Mary being a person of bravery today. He spoke to us about Christians believing God has a plan for each one of us and we can choose to say to following God. He explained that Mary, the Mother of Jesus, said 'yes' to following God's plan for her life. It took bravery. We linked this to the value 'faithfulness'.
